HOW TO RIDE A BUS

Check schedule for timepoint nearest your location. Arrive 10 minutes before scheduled time. Have exact fare ready (drivers do not make change).

- Not all stops are listed on a timetable
- Ask the bus driver or use our websites: www.CMRTransit.org or www.nextbus.com
- No eating, drinking, or smoking.
- Electronic devices may be played with earphones only.

HOW TO READ A TIMETABLE

1. Find the schedule for the day of the week and the direction of travel.
2. Find the timepoints closest to your origin and destination.
3. Your nearest bus stop may be between timepoints.

GUARANTEED RIDE HOME PROGRAM
